<b>I</b>	caught

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have caught
<b>you</b>	have caught
<b>he/she/it</b>	has caught
<b>we</b>	have caught
<b>you</b>	have caught

### Past perfect

### Future

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	am catching
<b>you</b>	are catching
<b>he/she/it</b>	is catching
<b>we</b>	are catching
<b>you</b>	are catching
<b>they</b>	are catching

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was catching
<b>you</b>	were catching
<b>he/she/it</b>	was catching
<b>we</b>	were catching
<b>you</b>	were catching
<b>they</b>	were catching

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been catching
<b>you</b>	have been catching
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been catching
<b>we</b>	have been catching
<b>you</b>	have been catching
<b>they</b>	have been catching

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been catching
<b>you</b>	had been catching
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been catching
<b>we</b>	had been catching
<b>you</b>	had been catching
<b>they</b>	had been catching

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be catching
<b>you</b>	will be catching
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be catching
