### Simple past

I	mastered
you	mastered

we	mastered
you	mastered
they	mastered

### Past continuous

I	was mastering
you	were mastering
he/she/it	was mastering
we	were mastering
you	were mastering
they	were mastering

### Present perfect

I	have mastered
you	have mastered
he/she/it	has mastered
we	have mastered
you	have mastered
they	have mastered

### Present perfect continuous

I	have been mastering
you	have been mastering
he/she/it	has been mastering

they	have been mastering

### Past perfect

I	had mastered

### Past perfect continuous

I	had been mastering

### Future

I	will master
you	will master
he/she/it	will master

they	will master

### Future continuous

I	will be mastering
you	will be mastering
he/she/it	will be mastering

### Future perfect

I	will have mastered
you	will have mastered
he/she/it	will have mastered

they	will have mastered

### Future perfect continuous

I	will have been mastering

<b>he/she/it</b>	would have mastered

<b>I</b>	master
<b>you</b>	master
<b>he/she/it</b>	master
<b>we</b>	master

### Past perfect subjunctive

<b>you</b>	had mastered
<b>he/she/it</b>	had mastered
<b>we</b>	had mastered
<b>you</b>	had mastered
